At ye Request of William Lewis, yt I would grant him  
to take up Two hundred & fifty Acres of his purchas't  
Land in ye County of Philadelphia. These are to will  
& require thee forthwith to survey or cause to be sur-  
vey'd unto him beyond Skulkill on ye North side of  
Darby Creek ye sd Number of Acres in a place not  
already taken up, according to ye method of Town-  
ships appointed by me, & make returns thereof into  
my Secretary's Office. Given at Philadelphia ye  
24<sup>th</sup> of ye <sup>mo.</sup> 1<sup>st</sup> 1683.
