January 1769. unto the Honorable the Proprietaries the above described Island situate in the River Susquehanna a little below the End of Shamokin Hill. called the Big Island containing One hundred eighty three Acres strict Measure. or One hundred and Seventy two Acres and 102 p and allowance &c.*
