In pursuance of a Warrt. dated the 13th. Day of October A.D. 1760 requiring Nicholas Scull Esqr. Surveyor General to Survey for the Honble the Proprietaries all the Islands in the Different Rivers & Creeks in the province wch. were purchased of the Indians. I do hereby Certify that there was Surveyed for their use two Islands in the river Schuylkill. Opposite to Providence Township in the County of Philada. The uppermost of which Contains One hundred & twenty eight perches & is Called Fat Land Island.

The other Contains Four acres & Three quarter & is Called Cat-Fish Island Returned into the Secretaries Office the 7th day of April 1768.
