

Pennsylvania S. S.

In Pursuance of a Warrant dated the 13th Day of October 1760. requiring me to survey or cause to be survey'd to the Use of the Honorable the Proprietaries the several unappropriated Islands within the Province of Pennsylvania. that lie in the Rivers Susquehanna, Schuylkill & Delaware <sup>on ye 27th of December 1760</sup> &c I do hereby certify that I have caused to be surveyed, to the use of the said Proprietaries a certain Island in the River Schuylkill between the Counties of Philadelphia & Chester, about half a mile above the Mouth of Perkiomy Creek, opposite on the North Side to Land of Richard Jacobs & on the South Side to Land of Andrew Holston, containing Twenty Acres and three Quarters of an Acre of Land with<sup>out</sup> Allowance of Six Acres p Ct as usual. Returned into the Secretary's Office the 29th day of December 1760.
