In Pursuance of a warrant dated the twenty fifth Day of November 1748, there was surveyed the 15th of November 1759. for the use of the Honorable Proprietaries, in part of their Tenths, a certain Island in the River Susquehanna, opposite to the Lands of James Galbreath & Joshua Low, containing Fifty eight Acres & a half with allowance of Six Acres p Cent, being known by the Name of Jones's Island. Returned into the Secretaries Office the 27th day of June 1763.
