

*Pennsylvania 5.5. In Pursuance of a Warrant dated the 13th day of October 1760 requiring Nicholas Scull the then Surveyor General to Survey or cause to be Surveyed for the use of the Honble. Proprietaries All the Islands in the Rivers Delaware, Schuylkill, and Susquehanna &ra. and to make Returns thereof into the Secretary's Office. I do hereby Certify that in pursuance of the aforesaid Warrant I have caused to be Surveyed on the 29th day of May 1775. for the use of the said Proprietaries, Two Islands in the River Susquehanna above Logan's Island and Nearly opposite the Middle of the Isle of Q, in the County of Northumberland. Number One Containing Twenty Eight Acres and One hundred and thirty four perches and Allowance of Six pcent &ra. And Number Two Containing Fifty Nine Acres and One hundred and Ten perches and Allowance of Six pCent &ra. Returned into the Secretary's Office the 10th day of August 1775*

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this *second* day of *May* 1910
