



In Pursuance of the Honble Proprietaries Warrant dated the 13th Day of October 1760 requiring Nicholas Scull then Surveyor General to Survey for their own proper use all the Islands in the Rivers Delaware Schuylkill Susquehanna &c. I did on the 14th day of July 1770 Survey for their use the above Described Island or Sand Barr Situate in the River Schuylkill opposite lands of Samuel Powell and John Roberts and Nearly opposite the Mouth of Mill Run or Creek and is Divided from other Islands and Sand Barrs Surveyed for their use by a part of Schuylkill running between the said Island and a Great Rock and Contains one Eighth part of an Acre.
 Agreed for 20 s for ye Island of 20 Jno LUMENS S. G.
 perches and 1 s. Sterling p annum Quit Rent
 15th Augt. 1770. Richd. Hockley.
