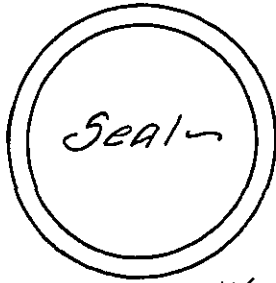


Pennsylvania

At the Request of Robert Lloyd of Meirion That

We would grant him a Resurvey on two hundred and fifty nine Acres and a half of Land in his possession in the sd Township, part of 819 Acres laid out to Thomas Ellis by vertue of a General Warrt. from the Proprs for laying out the Welch Tract bearing date the 13th. of the first Month 1684 part in right of the sd. Tho. Ellis's own purchase and the rest in right of Richard Davies first Purchaser of 5000 Acres. These are to require thee forthwith to resurvey to the said Robert Lloyd the said number of two hundred and fifty nine Acres and a half in his possession as aforesd and make Returns into the General Surveyors Office at Philadelphia where this Warrt. is to remain and a Copy thereof to be delvd thee certified by the Secretary who is also to take a duplicate of this Return into his Office. Given under our hands and the Seal of the Province at Philadelphia the 18th of the 12th. Moth. 1701.
