By vertue of a warrant from ye Comrs. dated ye 6th. of ye 2^d. Mo. 1689. Directed to ye Surveyr. Generall, I do by Authority from him Certifiē into ye Secretaryes office that there was Surveyd and Laid out ye 13th of ye said mo 1689 unto Edward Lane in ye behalfe of William Lane, Purchaser his Lott in ye Libertyes of ye City of Philadelphia Containing Eight acres. Begining at a corrn. post of Nathanll. Allens Land thence S.S.E. by ye same one hundred and Thirteen prches thence E.N.E. by a line of trees Elaven prches and a halfe thence N.N.W. by a line of trees one hundred and thirteen prches thence W.S.W. by Griffith Jones Land Elaven prches and a halfe to ye place of begining. And is Accordingly Entred and Recorded in ye Surveyr. Generalls office at Philadelphia ye 18th of ye 2^d. Mo. 1689.
