*Whereas) the former Commissioners of Property by their Warrant dated the 27th. Day of the 4th. Mo. 1685 granted to Andreas Peterson Longacre a Resurvey on One Hundred Acres of Land in Siamenson in the County of Philada. formerly Surveyed by Edmd. Cantwell together with One hundred Acres more granted to him by the Court of Upland which Warrant notwithstanding does not appear to have ever been executed and the said Andreas Requesting us that we would grant that the said Warrant may be executed.*

*These are to authorize and Require thee to Resurvey unto the sd. Andreas the said One hundred Acres of Land Surveyed by Edmd. Cantwell taking into the Same One hundred Acres more as granted by the Said Court of Upland making the whole to contain Two hundred Acres leaving out all Improvements made by Other Persons provided that there be enough left to make up the said Quantity. Otherwise to take in Such Part of such Improvements as will be least injurious to the remaining Part thereof and make Returns into the General Surveyors Office at Philadelphia where this Warrant is to remain and a Copy thereof to be delivered to thee certified by the Secretary Given under our Hands and the Seal of the Province at Philada.*
