



Pursuant to a warrant from Edward Pennington then Surveyor General bearing date ye 24<sup>th</sup> of ye 2<sup>d</sup> mo 1701 directed unto me I do hereby certify that I have surveyed the 20<sup>th</sup> of ye 3<sup>d</sup> mo, 1703 unto Thomas Wickersham a certain pece of Land in the Liberty of the City of Philadelphia on ye west side of Scookreel beginning at a Gum tree marked being a Corner of William Roberts Land from thence by a Line of Marked trees East 174 perches to a post set in ye ground being a Corner of William Bedwards Land thence by the said Land and Line of marked trees north, north west: 38 perches to another post: being a Corner of Land belonging to Hannah Musgrave now Prie: from thence by the said Land West 13 degrees South 164 perches to ye ye place of beginning Containeing 20 acres of Land and is according to ye bounds above described Returnd into ye General Surveyors Office at Philadelphia ye 10<sup>th</sup> day of ye 6<sup>m</sup> 1703.
