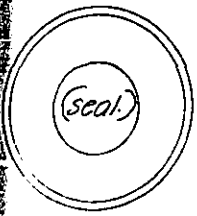

By the Commissioners of Property.

Whereas Mary Southworth (late Molineux) Purchaser of five hundred Acres of Land together with her brother Jno Southworth Purchaser of the same quantity obtained of the former Commissioners a Grant of sixteen Acres of land within the Liberties of the City Philad^{ia} in right of their said Purchases by a warrant produced to us & Laid to be duly executed in one parcel together, since which notwithstanding eight acres thereof has been laid out elsewhere in the sd Liberties & is now possess'd by Nicholas Wain. And whereas Hen. Molineux Husband of the sd Mary after her Decease & in pursuance of a certain Agreement for that purpose Granted the ~~sd~~ other eight Acres appurtenant to her said Purchase to R^d Woodworth, who has thereupon Requested that we would grant him a Resurvey: These are to Authorize and Require thee to resurvey to the said Richard the said quantity of eight Acres in one regular piece and parcel of the aforesd sixteen Acres and make Returns into the general Surveyors Office at Philad^{ia} where this warrant is to remain and a Copy thereof to be delvd. to thee certified by the Secretary. Given under our hands and the Seal of the Province at Philad^{ia} the 13th of the 11th Moth 1703/4.
