


Pennsylvania ss.

These are to Authorize and Require thee to Survey and layout or cause to be Survey'd & laid out unto the said Ann Welch for the use of her Children the said lot within the said City that is Clear of all other Surveys and claims and make a Returne thereof into the Secretary's Office in order to a further Confirmation Given under our hands and Seal of the Province at Philadelphia the 5<sup>th</sup> day of the Ninth Month Anno Dni. 1714.
