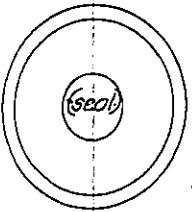


Pennsylvania



By the Commissioners of Property.

At the Request of John William, That we would grant him a Resurvey on
to Thomas Ellis
two hundred and nine Acres and a half of Land laid out in the Township of
Meirion within the Welch Tract by Vertue of a General Warrant from the Prop^{ts} for
laying out the 5^d Tract bearing date the 13th of the first Month 1684 part in right of
Richard Davies Purchaser of 5000 Acres and part in right of his own purchases of
the Prop^{ts} & now by vertue of Several mean Conveyances in the possession of the 5^d
John William. These are to require thee forthwith to Resurvey to the said John
the said two hundred and nine Acres and a half Situate as aforesaid and
make Returns thereof into the General Surveyors Office at Philadelphia where this
Warrant is to remain and a Copy thereof to be delvd thee certified by the Secretary
who is also to take a Duplicate of thy Return into his Office. Given under our
hands and the Seal of the Province at Philadelphia the 18th of the 12th Moth, 1701.
