


Pennsylvania

 laying out the sd Tract bearing date the 13th of the first Month 1684 part in right of
 Richard Davies Purchaser of 5000 Acres and part in right of his own purchases of
 the Prop^r & now by virtue of several mean conveyances in the possession of the sd
 John William. These are to require thee forthwith to Resurvey to the said John
 the said two hundred and nine Acres and a half Scituate ~~as~~ as aforesaid and
 make Returns thereof into the General Surveyors Office at Philadelphia where this
 Warrant is to remain and a Copy thereof to be delvd thee certified by the Secretary
 who is also to take a Duplicate of thy Return into his Office. Given under our
 hands and the Seal of the Province at Philadelphia the 18th of the 12th Moth, 1701.
