*At the Request of Thomas Woller by his Attorney Anthony Chishull, That I would grant him to take up ten Acres of Land within the Liberties of Philadelphia in right of his father Thomas Woller deceased Purchaser of five thousand Acres: These are to Require thee forthwith to Survey or cause to be Survey'd to the sd. Thomas Woller the said number of ten Acres within the said Liberties where it has not been already Survey'd nor taken up, and make Returns thereof into my Secretaries Office. Given under my hand and Seal at Philadelphia the 31<sup>st</sup> of the third Month, 1701.*
