*Surveyed by Jacob Taylor in the year 1714, Situated on the West Side of the River Skuylkill within the Liberties of the City of Philad<sup>a</sup> Beginning at a Post a Corner of Henry Childs Land, & running by the same south Thirty two P<sup>a</sup>rches to a Black Oak then to West twenty one P<sup>a</sup>rches to a Post then North by Adam Roads Land, One hundred & Eighteen P<sup>a</sup>rches to a Corner Post then by Joseph Pikes Land East thirty one p<sup>a</sup>rches to a Post ~~then~~ then South by Thomas Sesons Land Eighty Six P<sup>a</sup>rches to a Post then by the said Henry Childs Land West ten P<sup>a</sup>rches to the beginning.*
