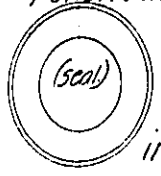

Whereas Barnabas Wilcox, Purchaser of a Thousand Acres of Land in this Province had a promise from the Prop^{ty} of the same Privileges in the City as the Original Purchasers in England ought or were to have, of which the sd Barnabas being disappointed his son Joseph Wilcox making application to the Prop^{ty} was by him referd to us to grant him such further Compensation (besides one Lott in ye second street confirmed to him by the Prop^{ty} Patent) for his sd Disappointm^{ts} as should be most suitable to his Conveniency & consistent with Equity & Reason. These therefore are upon Agreem^t between us and the sd Joseph in full Satisfaction of all his Demands of Lotts or other Privileges upon Acct of the sd Purchase to Authorize thre to Survey or cause to be surveyd to the sd Joseph Wilcox a Lott on the Front of Delaware twenty five foot in Breadth adjoining on his Lott & Ropewalk already laid out at ye North end of the Town & in length ye whole distance between ye front & second Street, also the same Breadth on ye Second Street on ye North side of his Ropewalk directly over agst the sd 25 foot beginning on ye West side of the second Street & extending in length the whole distance between the 2^d & 3^d Street ^{west end} also fifty foot in bredth beginning at ye ~~side~~ ^{west end} of his sd ~~present~~ Ropewalk on the Eastern Line of ye 3^d Street Extending in length to the Eastern Line of the fourth Street Also to Resurvey or cause to be Resurveyd to ye sd Joseph his Lott of fifty foot in one entire piece from the Front to ye 2^d Street and from the 2^d to the third street and make Returns of the whole together into the Secretaries Office. Given under our hands & ye Seal of the Province at Philad^{ia} the 7th day of ye 11th Moth, 1701.
