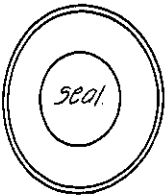

 nor appropriated nor is Seated by the Indians and make Returne thereof into
 the Secretary's Office in order for a further Confirmation Given under our hands
 and the lesser Seal of the Province at Philadelphia the two & twentieth day of ye
 first Month Anno Dni. 1726/7.
