I would grant him to have Lay'd out y^e remainder of y^e sd Purchase
 Land w^{ch} is Two h. (000) & fifty Acres up in Kashamens Creek, over against
 James Dillworth. These are to will & require thee forthwith to survey or cause
 to be survey'd unto him y^e sd 250 acres in y^e said place, not already taken
 up, allowing him 30 perches to every hundred Acres in front, lay it out ac-
 cording to y^e Method of Townships appointed by me, and make returns there-
 of into my Secretary's Office. Given at Philadelphia y^e 21st of y^e ^{1st} mo., 1683.
