



surveyd and Laid out the 9th day of May Anno 1720 unto John Warder of the City of Philadelphia a certain Lot of Ground in the said City Pertaining to an Original Purchase of five hundred acres of Land made by Ralph Withers. the said Lot being in Breadth Ninety nine foot and in Length three hundred and six foot Bounded on the South with Mulberry street on ^{the} East with a Lot lately Laid out to Peter Chamberlin in Right of a Purchase made by Joseph Jones and on the North with the Ends of Sassafras Street Lots Lying between the sixth and seventh streets from Delaware — surveyd by Jacob Taylor.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this fourth day of January, 190
