*At ye Request of Thomas Worth Purchaser of Two hundred and fifty Acres,  
ye I would grant him to take up a Lott in ye City of Philadelphia: These are  
to will & require thee forthw<sup>th</sup> to Survey or cause to be survey'd unto him  
a Lott on Skullkill side fifty footfront in any of ye Streets sett out for Pur-  
chasers of ye like Quantity & make returns thereof into my Secretarys Office.  
Given at Philadelphia ye 2<sup>d</sup>. 5<sup>th</sup>. 1683.*
