

By the Commissioners of Property.

At the Request of Nicholas Waln that we would grant him to take up eight Acres of Land within the Liberties of the City Philadelphia in right of John Carver first Purchaser of five hundred Acres, also eight acres more within the said Liberties in right of Thomas Crosdale first Purchaser of the like quantity which said Rights the said Nicholas severally purchased: These are to require thee forthwith to Survey and lay out to the said Nicholas Waln the said Sixteen Acres of Land together with eighty Acres more in the same Tract (in right and part of five thousand Acres the Original purchase of Richard Penn) of Land within the said Liberties not already Survey'd nor taken up & make Returns thereof into the General Surveyors Office at Philadelphia where this warrant is to remain and a Copy thereof to be delvd to thee attested by the Secretary who is also to take a Duplicate of thy Return into his Office.
