At ye Request of Jno West Purchaser of twelve hundred and fifty
acres ye we would grant him to take five hundred acres thereof, in ye
County of Philadelphia. These are in ye Proprietary's name forthwith to
survey or cause to be Surveyed unto him the said numb^r of acres in ye afore-
mentioned county in a Place not already taken up according to ye Method of
Townships appoynted by ye Govern^r he seating and improveing ye same ac-
cording to regulation and make returns thereof into ye Secretaryes office
Given at Philadelphia ye 30th of ye 7th 1684.
