At y^e Request of John West, Purchaser of One thousand Two hundred & fifty
Acres, y^e I would grant him to take up his Portion of Land wth y^e Liberties
of y^e City: These are to will & require thee forthwth to Survey or cause to be
survey'd unto him Twenty five acres wth y^e Bounds thereof on Skulkill, in a
place not already taken up, according to y^e method of Townships appoint-
ed by me, and make returns thereof into my Secretary's Office. Given at
Philadelphia, y^e 14th mo. 4th, 1683.
