

May 31st, 1776 I assisted Hooper in obtaining these Warr^{ts} & was promised a share by Him at that time I understood that himself, -Musser, G. Palmer, & myself, was the persons concerned. & I always Expected 1000^g at Least; It seems Hooper assigned over To John Musser his Contract made with John Penn dated the same day as the Warrants Together with all Lands Surveyd on 6 Warrants Being 11526^g which he sold to Robt Morris, & 2770^g which he says he sold to Jam^s Meredith 5 years agoe for Continental Money. -Morris gave half a Dollar an Acre, which Comes to £ 2161. 2. 6

Quere? how am I to get my share - the Land Sold.

Answer; Give me 150¹/₂ in money

The contract was, that Hooper should have all the land John Penn Did not Chuse to Keep, at £ 5.00 a 100 & Musser agreed to take it all.
