


FORM NO. 1.



By virtue of a Warrant dated the 31st of May 1776 and surveyed
the 16th, 17th, 18th, & 19th of July 1776 to the Honourable the Pro-
prietaries the two above described tracts of land situate on the
waters of Lechawaxsin and on the south branch of Corkinss Creek
in Northampton County containing together Two Thousand
Seven hundred and Seventy Acres, thirty perches and the
allowance of six & cent. &c^o:
