


Pennsylvania

By vertue of a warrant from the Com<sup>rs</sup>, Bearing date ye 18<sup>th</sup> of ye 2<sup>d</sup> mo. 1687- Directed to me I hereby certifie into the Secretaryes Office that I have Caused to be Surveyed and Laid out ye 26<sup>th</sup> of ye 2<sup>d</sup> mo. 1687 unto Edward West, Purche of one thousand acres his proportion of Land in ye Liberties of Philadelphia belonging unto him by his Said Purchase and part thereof. Begining at a corner White oak belonging unto W<sup>m</sup> Smyth's Land Thence west by James Craven's Land Eighty perches thence north by a line of trees Forty perches thence East by a line of trees Eighty perches thence south by a line of trees Forty perches to ye place of begining Containing and Laid out as above for ~~Twenty~~ Twenty acres of Land And is accordingly Entred and Recorded in my Office at Philadelphia the 28<sup>th</sup> of ye 2<sup>d</sup> month, 1687.
