At the Request of John Frederickfulls of Oley in this Province that we would Grant him to take up three hundred Acres of Land amongst the new Surveys back in Chester County for which he agrees to pay to the Proprietors use thirty Pounds Many of Pensilvania for the whole and the yearly quitrent of one Shilling Sterling for every hundred acres. These are to authorize and Require thee to Survey or cause to be Survey'd unto the said John Frederickfulls in the said County, ^{according to the method of Townships appointed} the said quantity of three hundred acres of Land that has not been already Survey'd nor appropriated nor is Seat- ed by the Indians and make Returns thereof into the Secretarys office w^{ch} sur- vey in case the said John fulfill the above agreement within three months after the date hereof shall be Valid otherwise the same is to be void as if it had never been made nor this Warrant ever granted Given under our hands & Seal of the Province at Philad^{ia} the 20th. day of the Third Month 1717.
