These are to Authorize and Require three forth with to Survey and lay out or cause to be Survey'd and laid out unto the said John French on Pequá Creek near Sasquahanna River the quantity of Five hundred acres of Land including within the said Survey those Indian Fields of the Old Great Sawanahtown, which said five hundred acres are to be held of the Prop^r under the yearly quitrent of one shilling sterling for Each hundred acres and make Returns thereof into the Secretary's Office in order for a further Confirmation Given under our hands and Seal of the Province at Philadelphia, the 2^d day of the 11th Month (January) Anno Dni. 1717.
