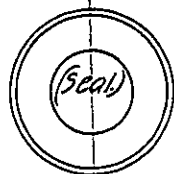

These are to Authorize & require you to survey & lay out and to make Return into our Secretary's Office for our use Three thousand Acres of Land in one or more Tracts some part thereof to lay adjoining Lands surveyed for Archibald Gardner & Matthias Hays on the South Branch of Corkings Creek in the County of Northampton, And in so doing this shall be your sufficient warrant Witness John Penn, Esq<sup>r</sup> One of the said Proprietaries who as well in his own Right as by virtue of certain powers from John Penn, Jr, Esq<sup>r</sup> the other Proprietary and the Right Honble Lady Juliana Penn his Testamentary Guardian hath hereunto set his Hand & caused the seal of the Land Office to be affixed at Philad<sup>a</sup> this thirty first Day of May in the Year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & Seventy six
