

Pursuant to a Warrant under y^e hand & Seal of the Proprietary and Governour to me directed bearing Date the 29th day of ~~the~~ ^{July} 6th month, 1700.

I doe hereby certifie y^t I have caused to be Resurvey'd unto Tho. Story, Attorney for Jos. Pike 10,000 acres of Land situate in y^e County of Chester being part of a tract of 30,000 acres formerly laid out to S^r Matthias Vincent & Comp^s. beginning at a marked Hickery standing on y^e W^{est} Side of Skuylkill River, from thence S^{outh} West by a Line of Marked Trees two thousand five hundred seventy & two perches to a post set in y^e Ground near to a marked Hickery from thence N^{orth} West by a line of marked Trees 870 perches to a post set in y^e Ground hard by a marked black Oak, from thence N^{orth} East by a line of marked trees 1012 perches to another post set in y^e Ground between a black & White Oak marked from thence S^{outh}, East 435 perches to another post set in the ground, from thence N^{orth} East by a line of marked trees one thousand & nine perches to another post set in Ground standing by y^e S^{outh} River of Skuylkill & from thence running by y^e several Courses of the said River (y^e several distances on y^e said several Courses amounting in all to six hundred & two perches to y^e first mentioned Hickery tree Laid out for 10116 acres of Land the said one hundred and Sixteen acres being computed to be the usual allowance for Roads Resurvey'd (according to the Time when y^e said work was begun) on the 18th day of y^e 8th month, 1700 and Returned into the Proprietarys & Governours Secretary's Office accord to y^e above said Resurvey and Bounds the 3^d day of y^e 2^d month, 1701.
