



A Draught of two Islands Situate in the River Sasquehanna, nearest to the York side thereof, the largest is opposite to a large Tract of Land Patented to John Harris containing forty four Acres and the Allowance Proportional to 6 pct. for Roads & The smallest contains eleven Acres & the Allowance Proportional to 6 pct. for roads. Both Islands surveyed for the Honble the Proprietors of this Province the 10th day of November 1760. in pursuance of their Warrant bearing date the 13th day of October last.
