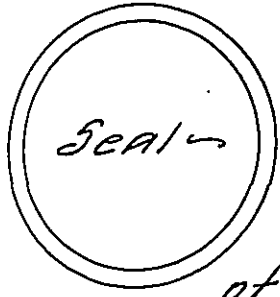


Pensylvania 5.5.



By the Commissioners of Property.
At the Request of Ebenezer Large That we would grant him to take up within the Liberties of Philadelphia the Proportions of Liberty Land belonging to five hundred Acres purchased of the late Proprietor by Joseph Hall and also of two hundred and fifty acres purchased of the said Proprietor by Richard Mills the Rights whereof being now vested in the said Ebenezer Large, These are to Authorize and Require thee to Survey or cause to be Survey'd in the aforesaid Rights within the said Liberties where the same may be found vacant.

The Proportions of Land appertaining to such purchases and make Returns thereof into the Secretary's Office in order for a further Confirmation Given under our hands and the Lesser Seal of the Province at Philada. the 10th day of the 12th Month Anno Dni 1725/6
