

Whereas the Commissioners of Property by their warrant dated ye 24th of the 6th Month 1703 Granted to Robert Heath one Lott to be taken up in the ffront Street of Philadelphia on Delaware Side in Right of Thomas Woolnicks Original Purchase of One Thousand acres which Lott Morris Morris and Richard Walm Sons in Law of the said Robert and Executors of Richd. Heath Son and Heir of the said Robert Heath by their Deed dated the 25th of March Anno. 1718 did Grant and Confirm to James Steel of the said City yeoman.

Now this may certifie that on the 15th of the 2^d Month 1718. there was Surveyd and Laid out to the said James Steel one Lott in the said City Bounded EASTWARD with Delaware ffront Street on the South with Jonas Smiths' Lott & one the West with the 2^d Street in Breadth twenty foot and in length three hundred ninety six foot.
