



By virtue of a warrant from the Commissioners of Property dated the Twenty Eighth day of August 1719. There was Surveyed to James Steel in Right of Humphrey Morrey and John Budd a tract of Land situate in the Township of Salfurd in the County of Philada. Beginning at a post in the Line of Jacob Colbs Land thence by the same South west forty two perches to a white OAK thence by Vacant Land North West two hundred and two perches to a post thence by Land of Rees Williams North East forty two perches to a post a Corner of John Ledrah's Land thence by the same South East two hundred and two perches to the place of Beginning Containing fifty Acres with the usual Allowance of Six p. Cent.

Surveyed the 13th day of May 1727.
