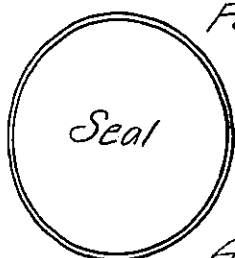


By ye Comission^{rs} impowerd to grant Lotts & Lands in ye Province of
