These are to certify that I have Surveyd the said 60 acrs of Liberty Land according to the bounds of the Figur A above described and also made a Reasurvey on a Certain tract of Land adjoining to the Same for the said David Prees aforesaid bounded as appears by the figur B: With 20 Acrs Joineing to Ditto in Right of William Curaton Containeing in all 100 Acrs of Land and is according to the bounds above described Returned into the General Surveyrs Offic at Philadelphia the 19th day of ye 6^h m^o 1704.
