By Vertue of a warrant from ye Proprietary & Govern^r bearing date the 5th of ye 5th Moneth last directed to me, I hereby Certify into his Secretary's Office, yt I have Caused to be Surveyed and Set out unto John Pusey Purchaser, his Lott in the City of Philadelphia, the 3^d of ye 6th Moneth following, — Containing in breadth forty nine foot and a half, and in Length two hundred and twenty foot, bounded Northward wth Walnut Street formerly called Pool Street, Eastward wth a vacant Lott, Southward wth back Lotts, Westward wth the fifth Street from Delaware and is accordingly Entered and Recorded in my Office, Philadelphia the 5th of the 4th Moneth 1684.
