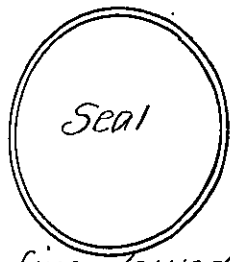


Pensylvania

Whereas there was formerly laid out unto Rob^t Fairman five hundred Acres of Land in Dublin Township in the County of Philad^{la} in right of Will^m Puryor his Original Purchase of One thousand Acres; parcel of which Tract Thomas Fairman Constituted Attorney to his Brother the Said Robert Sold and Conveyd Eighty Six Acres to Abraham Pratt of the Township and County aforesaid Who requesting a Resurvey upon the Same: These are to Authorize and Require thee forthwith exactly to Resurvey not only the Said Whole Tract as by another Warr^t under our hands & Province Seal thou art directed, But also particularly the Said Parcel purchased by the S^d Abraham for Eighty Six Acres according to the true Original Lines by ^{ch} W^{ch} it was at first Subdivided together with Such other Lands adjoining and belonging to the Said Abraham as he shall direct, And make particular Returns into the General Surveyors Office at Philad^{la} where this Warr^t is to remain and a Copy thereof to be delivered to thee certified by the Secretary, Given under our hands and the Seal of the Province at Philad^{la} the 13th of the 2^d Moth 1703
