Whereas Caleb Pusey ^{In R^t of John Hicks} Purchaser of Two hundred and fifty Acres of Land hath Assured us by his Petition of his Ignorance in ye first Takeing up of his said quantity of Land that he was to leave somuch out of ye said two hund and fifty acres as there was liberty land by ye Proprietarys Concession allowed him in proportion to his said Purchase and haveing given us full satisfaction with money in hand paid for ye four Acres he should have abated in his said Tract,

These are therefore in the Proprietarys Name to will and Require thee forthwith to Survey or Cause to be Surveyd unto him ye said Liberty land proportionable to his Purchase and mak Returne hereoff to ye Secretarys Office, Dated at Philadelphia ye 30th of ye 5th mo 1687
