*In pursuance of a warrant dated the 13th day of October 1760 There was Surveyed by William Maclay Deputy Surveyor a certain Island for the Honble the Proprietaries, Situate in the River Juniata at a place called the Mathawana Cabbins opposite to Hollidays Mill in the County of Cumberland. the said Island called the Mathawana Island Containing Thirty eight acres fifty perches & allowance of 6p Cent & ca. Returned into the Secretaries Office the 6th day of April 1768.*
