At the Request of Michael Shank and Henry Pare both
 of the Township of Strasburg in this Province that we would
 Grant them to take ^{up} in or near the Said Township the quantity
 of four hundred acres of Land for which they agree to pay to
 the Propriet^{rs} forty Pounds Money of the Said Province for
 the whole and the yearly quitrent of one Shilling Sterling for
 every hundred acres These are to authorize and Require thee to
 Survey or cause to be Surveyed unto the Said Michael Shank
 and Henry Pare at or near the Place aforesaid the Said
 quantity of four hundred acres that has not been already
 Survey'd nor appropriated nor is Seated by the Indians and
 make Returns thereof into the Secretarys Office which Survey in
 case the Said Michael & Henry fulfill the above agreement
 within three Months after the date hereof Shall be valid other-
 wise the same is to be void as if it had never been made nor
 this Warrant ever granted Given under our hands & Seal of
 ye Province at Philad^ey^e 27th 7th AD 1717 Richard Hill
 To Jacob Taylor Surv^r Gen^r Isaac Norris
