There was Surveyed and laid out unto Henry Gunston a Tract of Land Situate in Rockland Manor in the County of Chester Beginning at a White Oak in a line of Broomingham Township from thence Extending ~~by~~ South South East by Thomas Coopers Land 200 perches to a Black oak, thence West South West by Vacant Land 84 perches to a Post, from thence North North West 183 perches to a post, from thence - ob l - chies to the place - ob l - ning Containing Ninety Seven - ob l - a quarter & the usual allowance of six p^{ct} for Roads &c^e
