At ye Request of Bartholomew Copock, y<sup>t</sup> I would grant him to  
take up a Lott in ye City proportionable to his purchase of  
five hundred Acres. These are to will & require thee forthw<sup>th</sup>  
to survey or cause to be surveyed unto him a Lott on Schulkill  
in any of ye Streets sett out for Purchasers of ye same Quant-  
ity, and make returns thereof into my secretary's Office.
