These may Certify to all whom it may Concern that I have made a Careful search in my Office Respecting the land said to belong to Doc^t Dan^l: Cox S^r Matthias Vincent & Major Robert Thompson in Chester County & find that they (the Owners) have been look'd on & taken as purchasers of 30,000 Acres or Six Townships (to say Each 10,000 Acres, I find Jos: Pike had 10,116^{ac} as one third part of the s^d large Tract laid out to him the 3^d of the 2^d Month 1701 - by W^t Dated 29th 6 M^o 1700 -

I well Remember that on the Trial, between the Honbl^e Prop^r & John Hunt as agent for the West Jersey Society Claiming under Doctor Dan^l Cox that the Said Proprietaries & their Council ^{admitted} ~~never Disputed but~~ that the said 30,000 Acres ^{was surveyed} ~~belonged~~ to the s^d Dr. Dan^l Cox, & Comp. & during the 20 Years I have been in the Office I have never heard it Contraverted and ^{to S^r Matt^s Vincent, &c^s for Six Top^s of land each top 5000 dated 23^d April 1686} I find a Warrant granted ~~by the Proprietaries~~ ^{& also a wt dated} dated the 3^d day of November 1774 for Surveying to Said Hunt as agent for the West Jersey Society the Quantity of 10,000 Acres adjoining Pike. The Execution of said Warrant was defended by Order of the propriet^{es} & on a Caveat enter'd by Tho^s Willing Esq^r & Company - Witness my Hand & Office Seal at Philad^a this 10th day of April 1782
