


Pursuant to a warrant from the Commissrs of prop<sup>ty</sup> directed unto me bearing date y<sup>e</sup> 14<sup>th</sup> of X m<sup>o</sup> 1702 I do Certiefy that I have Reasurveyed and cut out of a Certain tract of Land formerly Irregularly Laid out to Richard Snead within y<sup>e</sup> bounds of y<sup>e</sup> Welsh tract begining at a stak being a Corner of Roland Ellis Land from thence by a Line of Marked trees and y<sup>e</sup> same Land With y<sup>e</sup> Land of Griffith Owen West South West: 304 perches to a stak set in y<sup>e</sup> ground from thence by Griffith Land againe South South East 122 perches thence Ditto by John ffinchers Land 154 perches to a Hickry marked being a Corner of y<sup>e</sup> said ffinchers Land then by a Line of marked trees East North East 304 perches to a stak neera bl<sup>ck</sup> marked thence by a Line of marked trees north north West 276 perches to y<sup>e</sup> plac of begining Containing 524 acres of Land and is according to y<sup>e</sup> bounds above describe<sup>d</sup>.
