These are to require thee forthwith to resurvey to the said Richard Rees the said number of seventy six acres and a half in the place aforesaid where he is now possess'd thereof and make Returns into the General Surveyors Office at Philadelphia where this Warrant is to remain & a Copy thereof to be delivered to thee certified by the Secretary who is also to take a Duplicate of thy Return into his Office.
