That I would grant them a resurvey on a certain Tract of
Land in Ashton Township and y^e County of Chester laid out
for one thousand Acres, and now in the possession of the
s^d Joseph Richards Edward Carter ^{Francis Barnett} & Humphry Scarlet:

These are to require thee forthwith to Resurvey or cause to be
resurvey'd the said Tract according to its first bounds and
Lines of Survey, also to run y^e Division lines between the
said Joseph Richards Edward Carter ^{Francis Barnett} & Humphry Scarlet, and
make Returns thereof into my Secretaries Office. Given
