hundred Ninety perches to the River Schulkill Then down  
the same on the Courses thereof to ~~a~~ Black oak by  
the said River Then South West by a line of Marked trees  
four hundred and Eighty perches to a White oak Then North  
West fifty five perches to the Beginning Containing One hun-  
dred sixty <sup>two</sup><sub>1</sub> acres with allowance  and an Island  
in the said River Containing four <sup>or</sup> five acres
